

# Media Information

## CREENTIALS

Media credentials for DePauw University home football games can be obtained by contacting Bill Wagner, Director of Sports Information at (765) 658-4630. Credentials will be provided to working members of the media and visiting sports information directors only. All photographers must restrict their work area to the sidelines from the 25-yard lines to the back of the end zones on each side of the field and to the back of the end zone. NCAA guidelines prohibit photographers from working in the team bench areas.

## INFORMATION AVAILABLE

Programs, lineups and other pregame information will be provided, in the press box, prior to each home game. Play-by-play and final statistics will be available following the game.

## DIRECTIONS TO BLACKSTOCK

**From Interstate 70:** From Exit 41 (U.S. 231) proceed north for approximately seven miles. Turn left on Hanna Street (at the Pizza King restaurant) and continue on that until it dead ends into stadium (approximately seven blocks).

**From North U.S. 231:** Proceed south on 231 until it turns at the courthouse square. Where it turns, proceed straight for five blocks. Turn right on Hanna Street and the stadium will be on your right.

**From Route 240:** Follow 240 west to the intersection with U.S. 231. Turn left on 231 for four blocks and then turn right on Hanna Street and continue for seven blocks, the stadium will be on your right.
