

**2008 JURIED STUDENT SHOW
RICHARD E. PEELER ART CENTER
DEPAUW UNIVERSITY
NOVEMBER 20 - DECEMBER 12, 2008**

ELIGIBILITY

1. Work must have been completed in a studio art course and/or art program at DePauw.
2. Work must have been completed within the last 3 years and not previously exhibited in the Juried Student Show. Artwork completed in high school is ineligible.
3. Each student may enter a maximum of 4 artworks in any medium. A series will count as an individual artwork, but must have been conceived as one piece to be considered a series.
4. All work must be original in concept. The work must have been conceived entirely by the person in whose name it is submitted.

AWARDS

The three award categories are 2D, 3D and 4D. Monetary prizes will be distributed at the discretion of the juror. Awards will be offered on the basis of artistic merit.

JUROR

This year's juror is Paula Katz, Gallery Director, Herron School of Art and Design, Indianapolis.

PRESENTATION

1. All work must be presented in a manner suitable for hanging and display – matted and/or framed, and wired for hanging. Please provide special installation instructions, if needed. Poorly presented works will not be accepted. No wet paintings will be accepted.
2. All entries must be identified with the appropriate form provided on this prospectus. Attach a form to the back of each work.

CONDITIONS

1. Any piece accepted for exhibition must remain on display for the duration of the show.
2. Late entries will not be accepted. To be fair to all participants, no extensions will be granted.
3. Unaccepted work must be picked up November 11-14 between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Accepted work must be picked up December 15-19, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
4. Accepted, unclaimed work and unaccepted, unclaimed work will be discarded after 4 p.m., December 19.

AGREEMENT

Submission of artwork to this exhibition shall be understood to indicate an agreement on the part of the entrant to all conditions set forth in this prospectus. Each entrant must sign the following entry form.

ENTRY FORM AND FEE

A \$5 non-refundable fee – that covers up to 4 artworks per student – will be charged to your student account. Additional entry forms are available at the Peeler Art Center front desk.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS

- October 30:** 4-5 p.m.
Peter Nguyen, Exhibitions and Collections Assistant, will lead a workshop on the proper display methods for artwork submitted to the exhibition. Attendance is not mandatory, but is strongly encouraged.
- November 7:** All entries are due on this date at the Peeler Art Center front desk between 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
- November 10:** Submissions are juried.
- November 11-14:** Pick up unaccepted work between 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
- November 20:** 6-8 p.m., Opening reception and awards presentation
- December 12:** Show closes
- December 15-19:** Pick up all work between 10 a.m.-4 p.m.
- If you cannot pick up your work personally, please arrange to have someone do so. Work left after December 19 will be considered abandoned and will be discarded.
